MHAUS and all those involved within the organization remain committed to patient safety and MH education in whatever form or avenue can be accessed to accomplish our goal. The office staff, MH Hotline Consultants, Professional Advisory Council, Board of Directors, all committee members working on various projects and all those who volunteer their time and efforts to support the MHAUS organization are committed to stopping a single death from MH. We work with various other organizations to promote MH education within their membership and keep the various regulatory agencies informed of adjustments in MH management after thorough review by the MH experts.

**Products and Programs Update**

- The MHAUS website has been undergoing a major renewal, and it is anticipated the new website will be available by the end of 2025 or shortly thereafter. The changes include a slight revision to our branding. The new site will be more easily searched and the information provided will be evidence-based. As the medical information must be absolutely correct, the attention to detail takes a good amount of time.
- The Operating Room Protocol Poster has been reviewed, updated, and given new branding that coincides with our revisions to the MHAUS website. It is available this year, including the Crisis Protocol Kit (poster, 9” x 12” mini-poster, medical professional pocket card) and the MH Crisis pocket card.
- The Patient Guide to Malignant Hyperthermia and the “I Have MH – Now What?” booklet designed for patients and their families has been revised to share the latest MH information.
- Genetics information has been a focus area for MHAUS and will continue to be followed carefully.

**Financial Information**

This has been a challenging year for MHAUS. We explored avenues to reduce expenses while retaining our focus on our educational avenues that reach the widest audience. The rejuvenation of the MHAUS website, focus on social media avenues to share MH insight and news, presentations from our MH experts at a global meeting, as well as our first time exhibiting at a genetics conference by board members has allowed us to explore new avenues to offer MH education. Our product and membership pricing has not changed in many years, but price increases to deal with rising costs of material production and other charges were necessary.

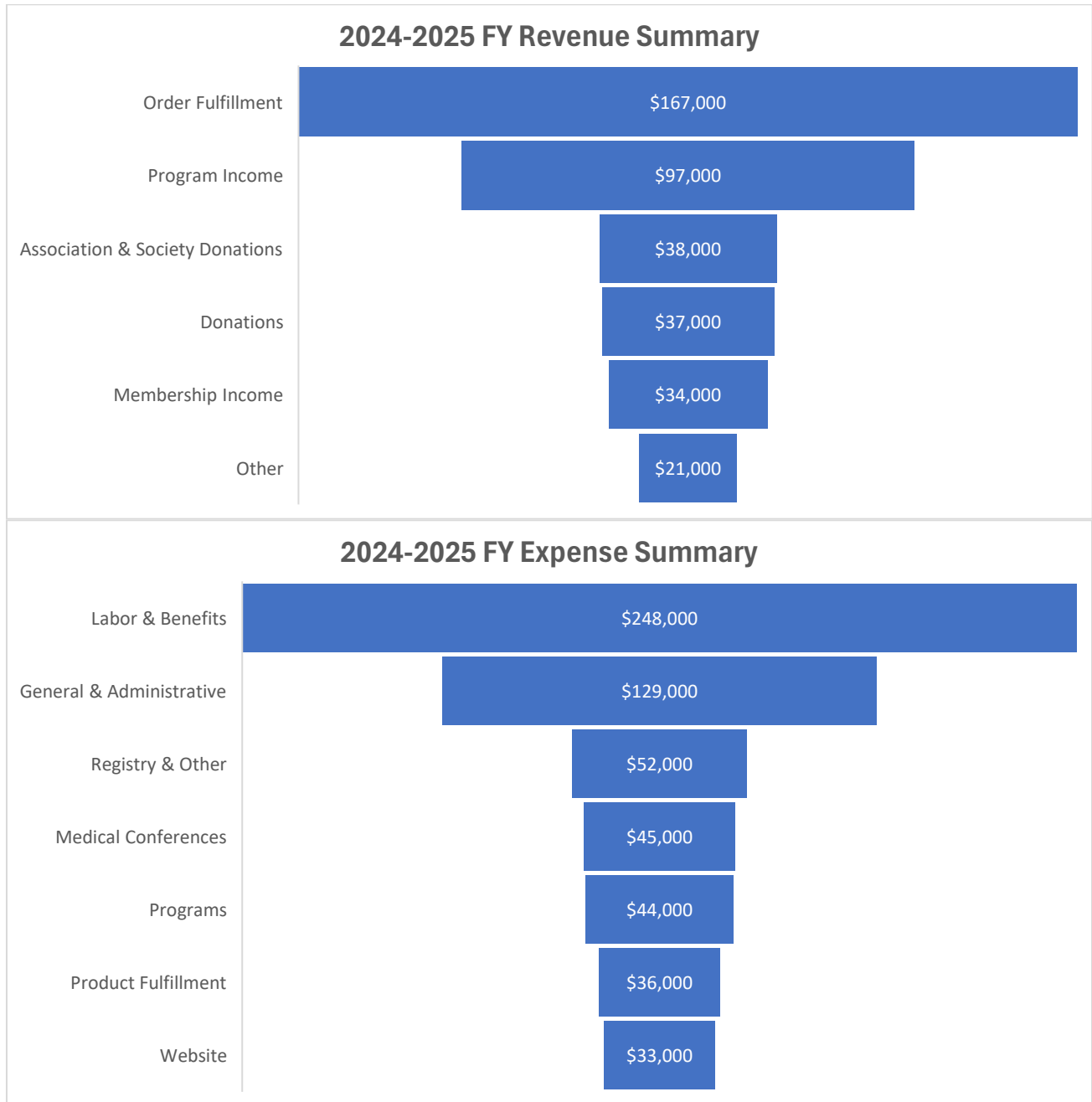
