



# MHAUS/NAMHR updates:



**Figure 2: New NAMHR Enrolments** 









Figure 3: Legacy conversions




## **Current Projects**

#### • Evolving use of Dantrolene

- With the help our student volunteers, we are looking retrospectively at the evolving use of the Dantrolene brands since the release of Ryanodex.
- o Hope to have some abstract/publication by the end of summer or fall.
- o Approved by the IRB on 7-2-19.
- Data pull done, analysis underway
- Working on second data pull
- Abstract finalized, submitted, and accepted to IARS

#### MH Hotline

- o MHAUS has asked us to take over the housing of the MH Hotline REDCap database
- o IRB is approved the move of the Hotline database
- Contract/Data Use agreement has been finalized
- o Data has been transferred from CHOP to UF
- Working through a few issues with the data transfer
- Will be reaching out to Teeda soon to see if there are any revision that are wanted to REDCap





#### COVID-19

- COVID-19 calls coming into the Hotline
- o Dr. Rosenberg and others created a specific COVID-19 and dantrolene use questionnaire for these calls
- o MH Hotline IRB revised to include COVID-19 questionnaire
- o The IRB has approved this addition
- o REDCap will be revised to include this new questionnaire

### **Future Projects**

# • Genetic project with Dr. Biesecker

- The study will draw blood samples from MH patients and their family member and some exertional heat illness patients for full exome analysis by Dr. Biesecker at the NIH.
- o Rough draft of proposal with UF Statistician
- Working with Quest on a contracting so patients can go into get their blood drawn and not worry about cost or shipping
- Working with Dr. Biesecker on funding.

## • Effectiveness of the Hotline getting events in to the Registry

• We are planning on doing a retrospective review of the hotline cases that were thought to be MH and comparing to see how many of those actually were registered in the registry in the last year.
